III. GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 1. In order to ensure the compliance of the information and data collected on the www.nrdcs.lt website managed by UAB NRD Cyber Security (hereinafter referred to as the Company) by means of cookies with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (the General Data Protection Regulation), and to ensure the security of the personal data collected in this way, as well as to ensure the rights of the subjects of the data collection, the Company has prepared and approved the Cookie Policy of www.nrdcs.lt (hereinafter referred to as the Policy), which is set out in Annex 1.*

COOKIE POLICY

The Cookie Policy (hereinafter referred to as the policy) of NRD Cyber Security UAB, legal entity code 303115085, registered office address Gynėjų g. 14, LT-01109 Vilnius, Republic of Lithuania (hereinafter referred to as the company, we, us) sets out our commitment to ensuring the security of personal data and the protection of the rights of visitors to our website (hereinafter referred to as visitors, you, your) when using our website <https://www.nrdcs.lt> (hereinafter referred to as the website).

In this policy, we inform you about the technologies used on the website to help ensure the proper functioning of the website or to monitor and analyse the website visitors' behaviour.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that are stored in the browser on your device (e.g., computer, mobile phone, etc.) when you are browsing websites. When you visit any website, information may be stored or retrieved in your browser using cookies. This information may be about your preferences, your device, or may be used to make the website work the way you expect it to (e.g. cookies help us to remember a visitor's login information, language preference, font size and other display options, so that you do not have to re-enter them each time you visit the website). Cookies also help us to collect and analyse website traffic statistics, to maintain or improve the functionality of the website, to enhance security, etc. This information does not usually identify you directly, but it can be used to provide more personalised website features. In this policy, all these technologies are referred to as cookies.

WHAT ARE THE TYPES OF COOKIES?

The cookies used on websites may be first-party (our own) or third-party:

- **First-party (own) cookies** – are issued by the website you are visiting
- **Third-party cookies** – are provided and managed by third parties (e.g. Google, Facebook, LinkedIn, etc.)

Cookies are also classified according to the functions they perform:

- **Strictly necessary cookies** – activate the basic functions of browsing or accessing the website. Without these cookies, the website will not function properly
- **Functional (technical) cookies** – allow the website to remember information related to your preferences, which determines its performance and appearance (e.g. a visitor's language preference or the region in which they are located)
- **Analytical (statistical) cookies** – allow for the collection of information about the traffic flows of visitors, as well as the actions performed on the website or on individual web pages, to find out how visitors use the website, thus allowing for the evaluation and improvement of the performance of the website. They help you find out which pages are most and least popular and track how visitors move around the site
- **Advertising (marketing) cookies** – usually from third-party advertisers, used to track visitors on a number of websites in order to serve them relevant adverts

WHY DO WE USE COOKIES?

We use cookies:

- to ensure the proper functioning of the website

- to improve the website and make it more usable and tailored to your needs by analysing your behaviour on the website
- to facilitate more effective marketing

In addition, if you restrict your browser from placing cookies on your device, some functions of the website may not work properly.

Most browsers also allow you to:

- block third-party cookies
- block cookies from specific websites
- block all cookies
- delete all cookies when you close your browser
